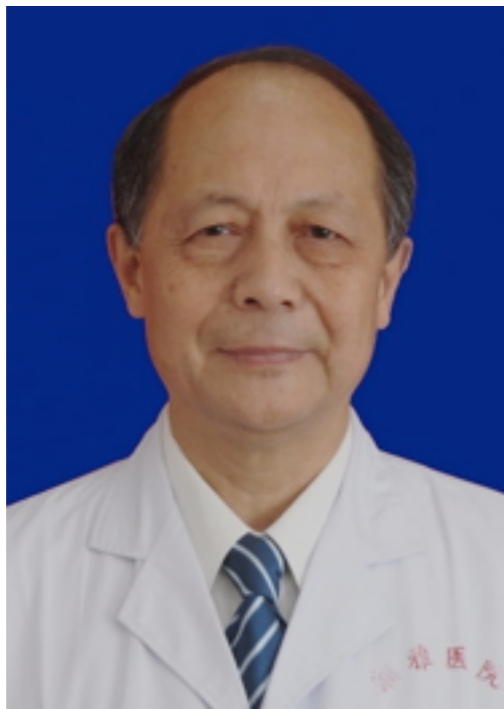



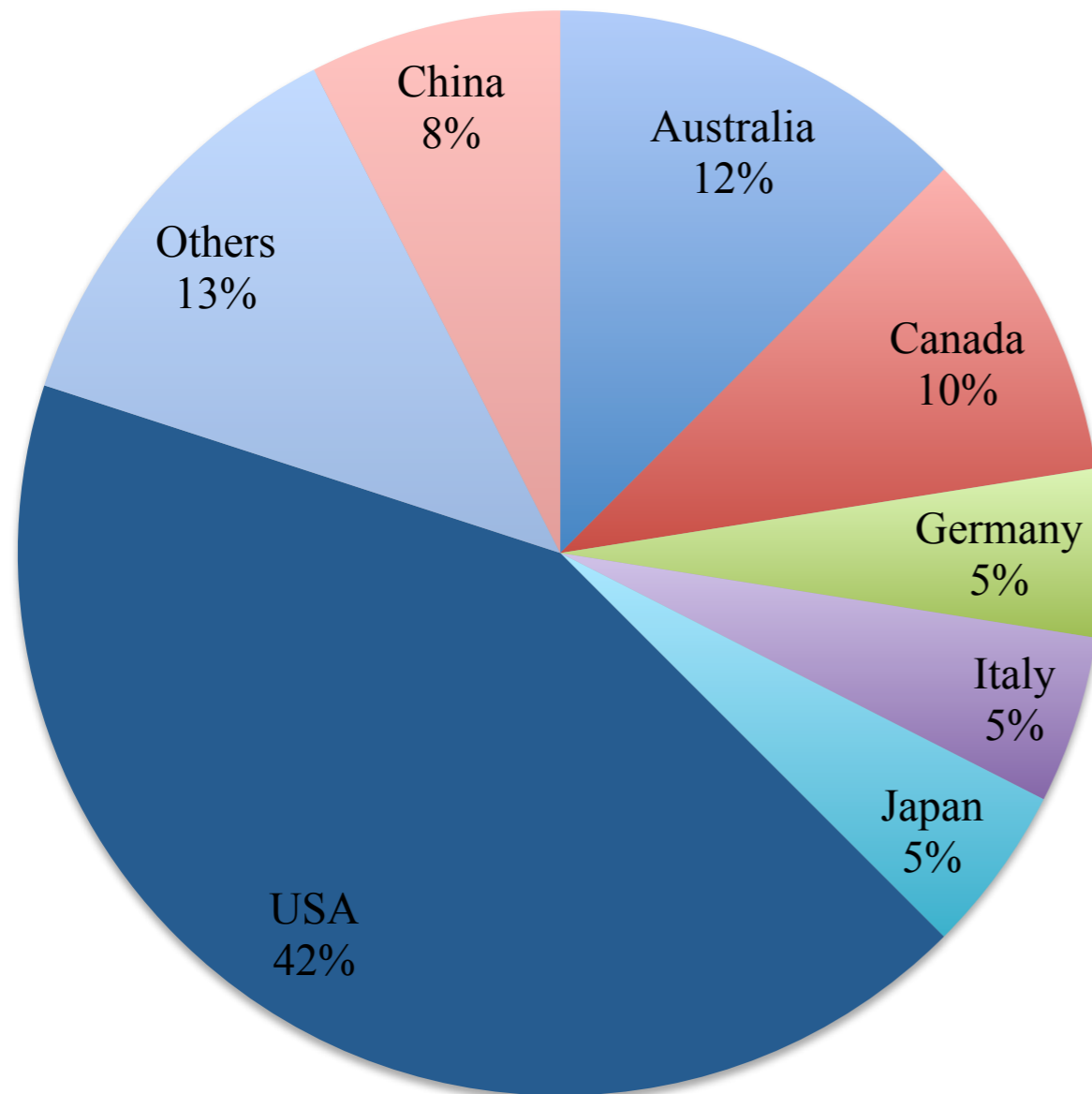

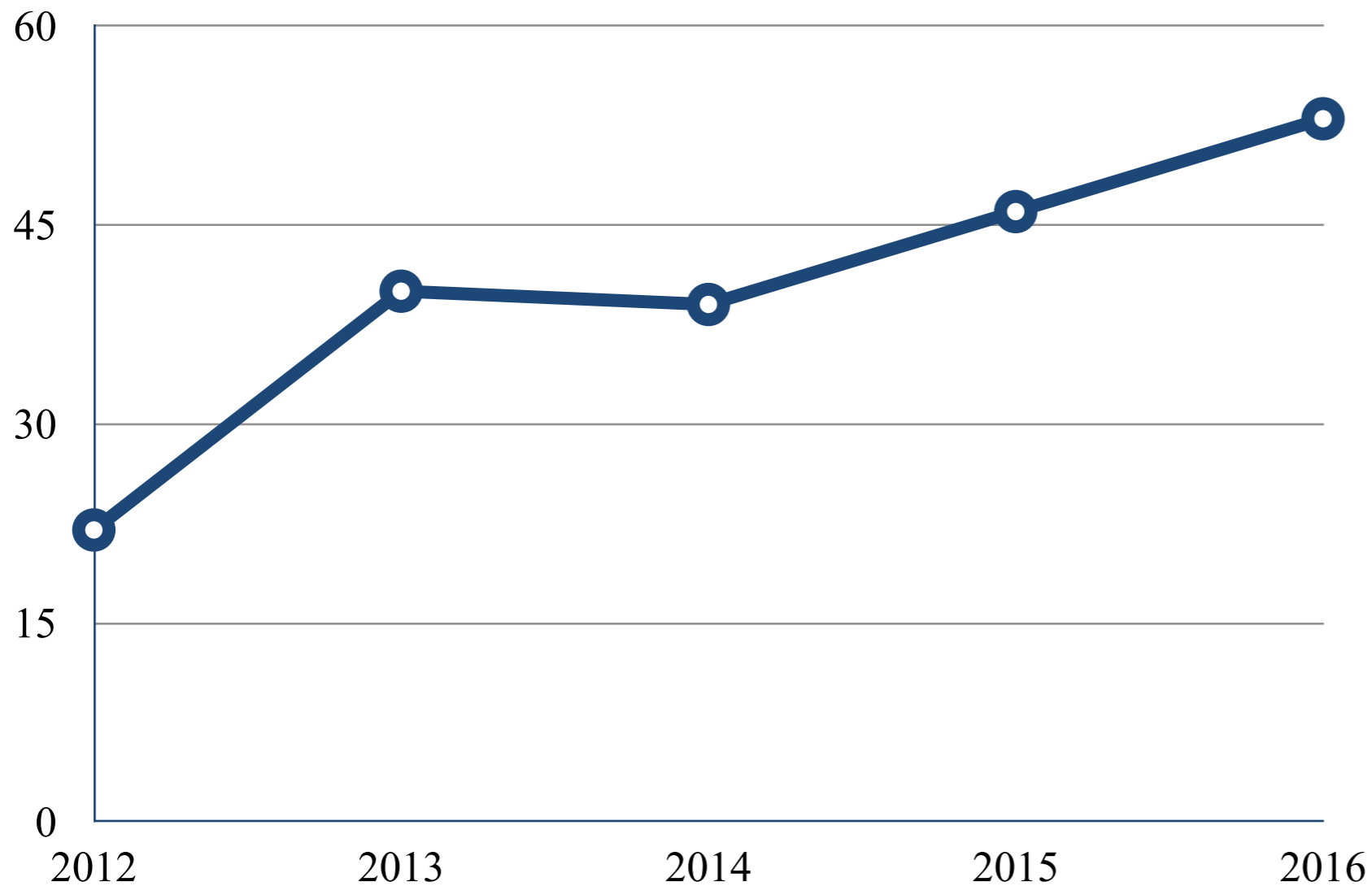
## 4. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

- 38 Editorial Board

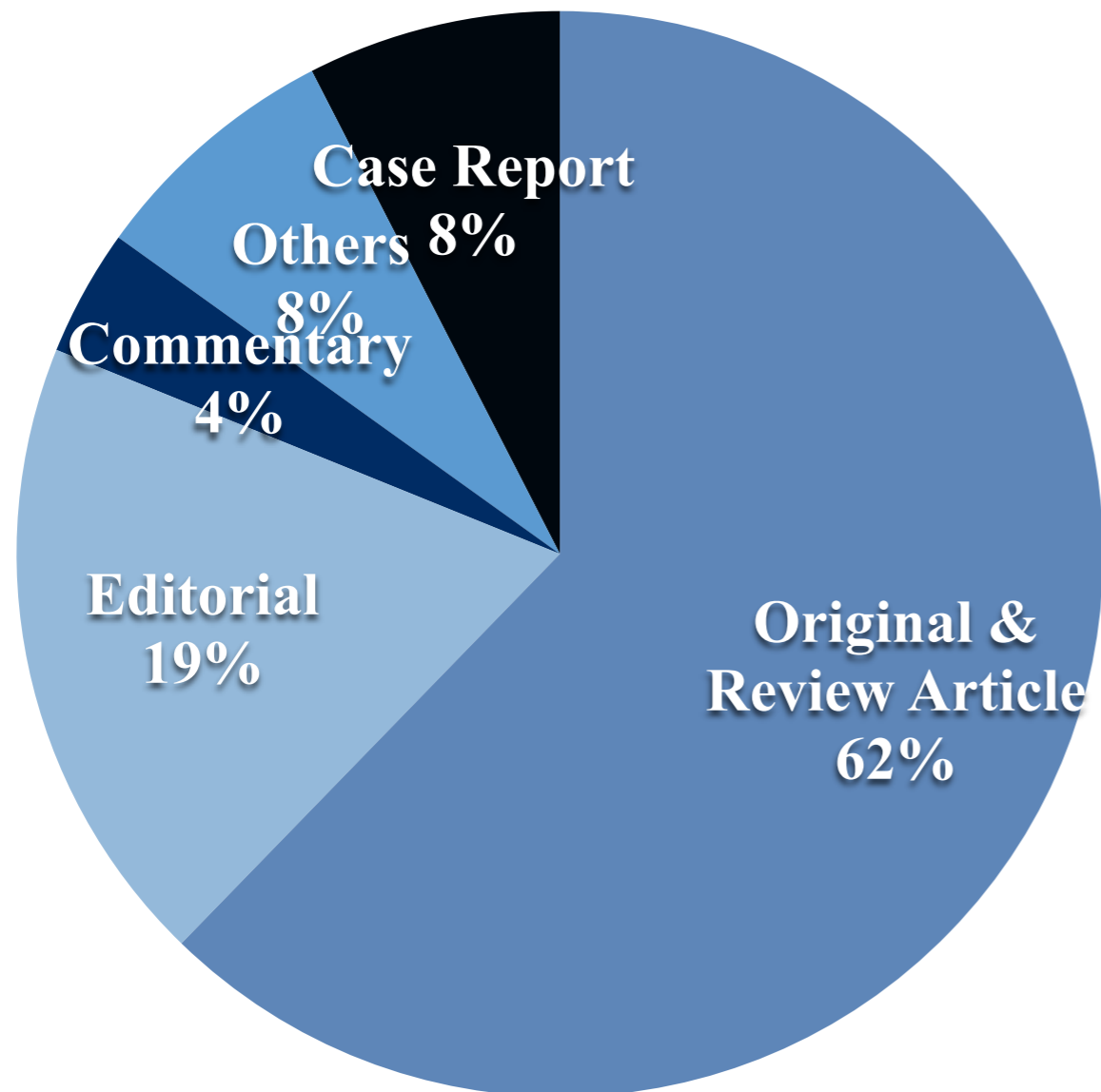
## 5. Number of Published Articles (results by year)

Number of articles has been increasing every year.

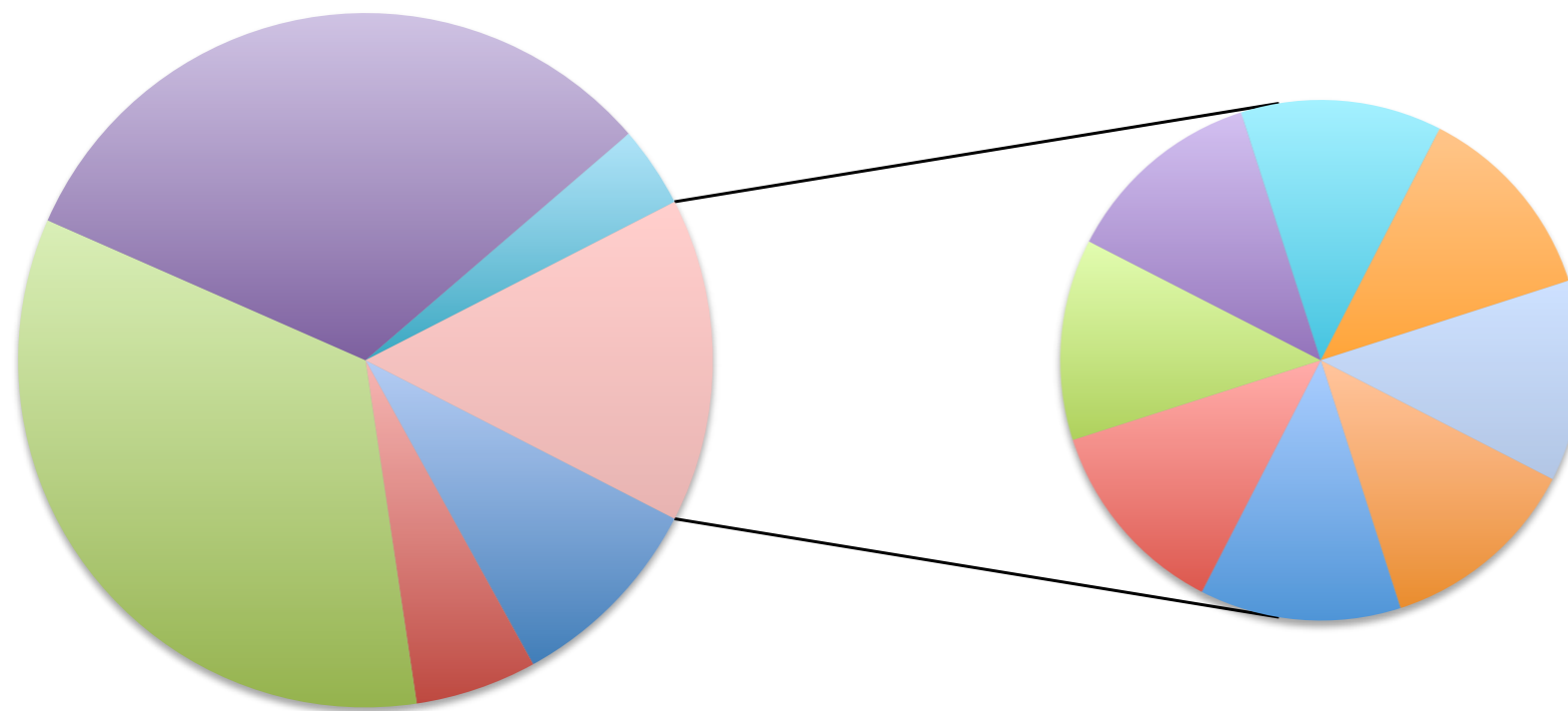
## 6. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2016

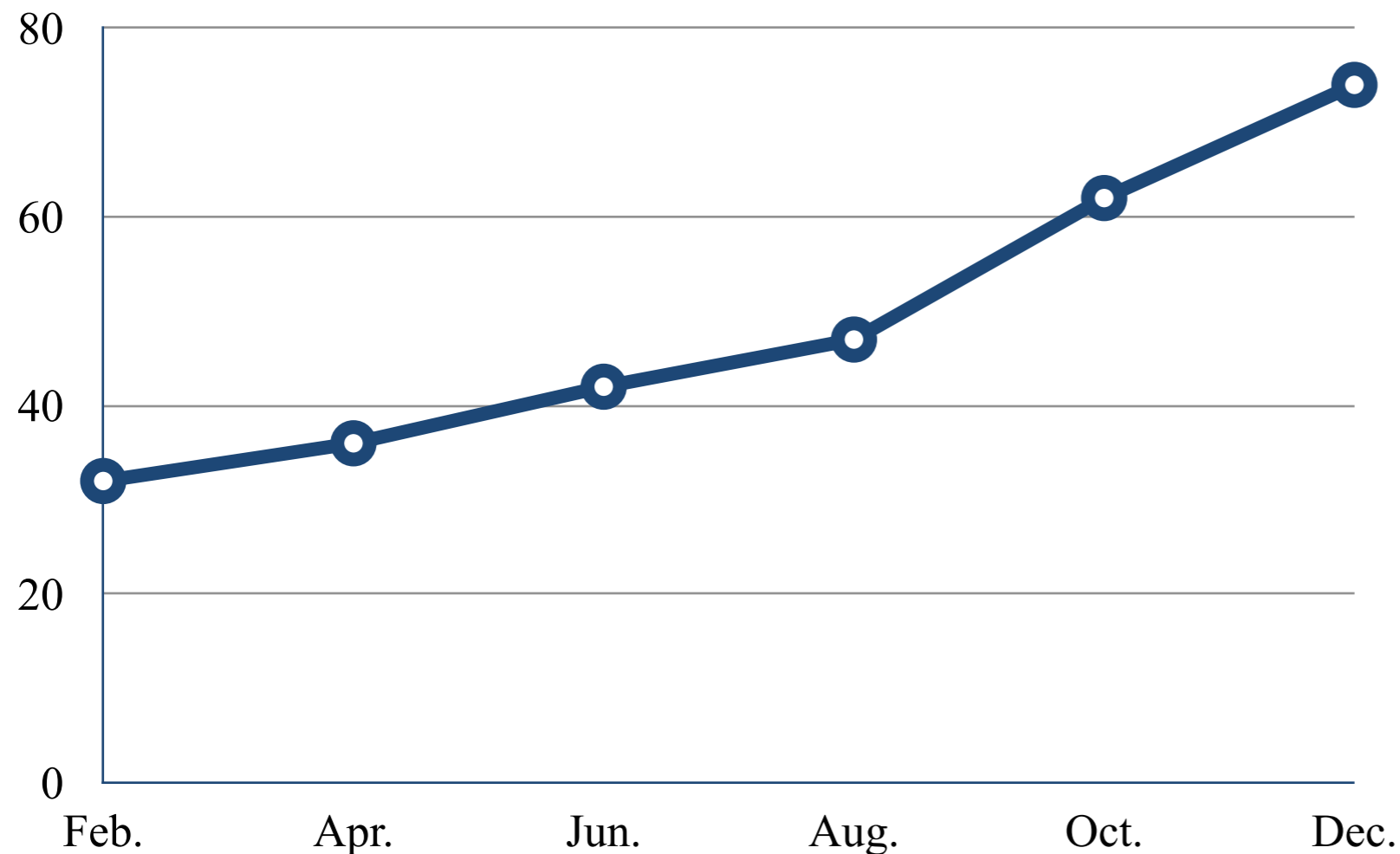


## 7. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2016



Corresponding authors of 53 articles published in 2016 come from **13** countries with 34% of them from USA.

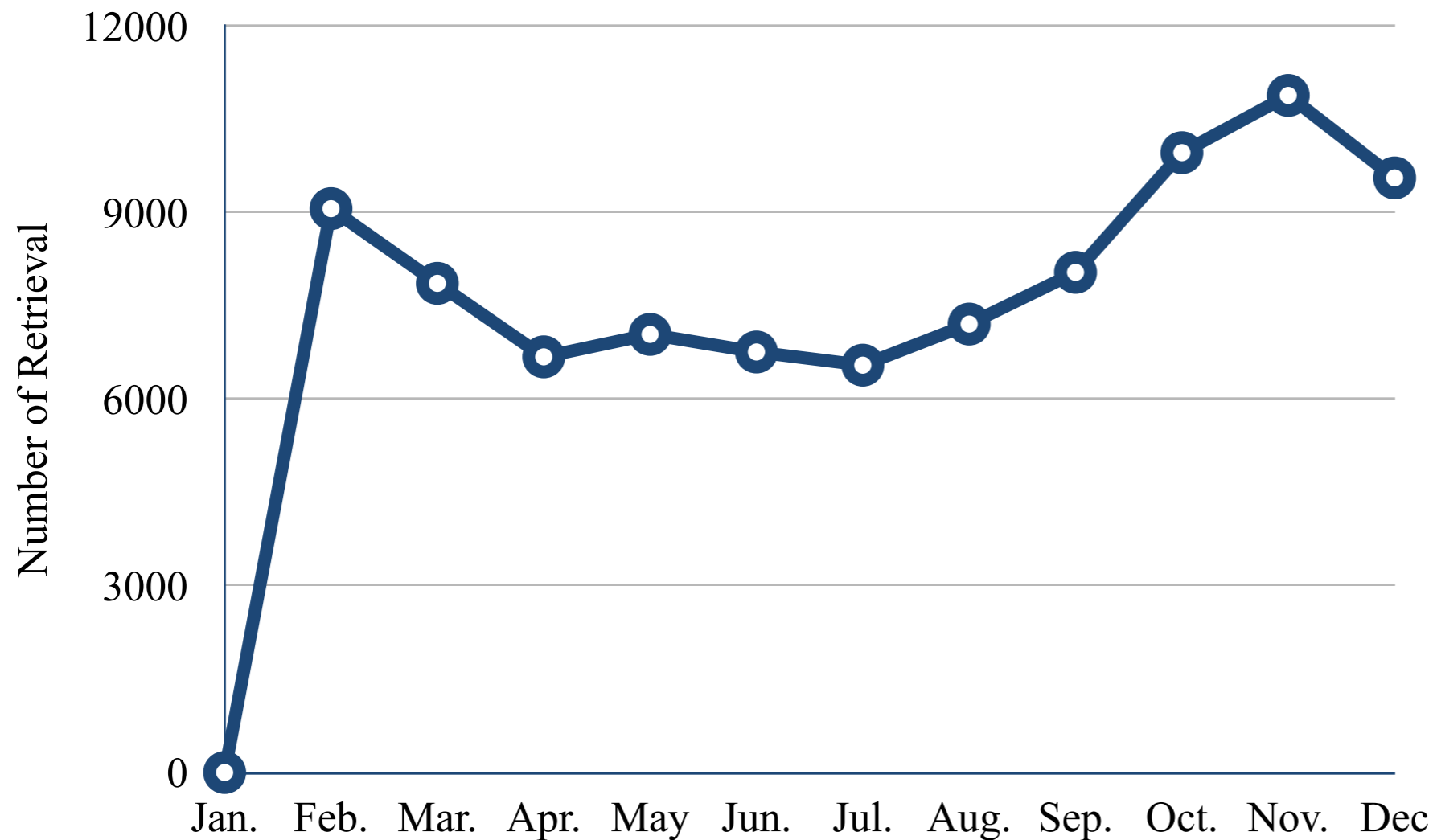
## 8. Citations in 2016 (results by month)

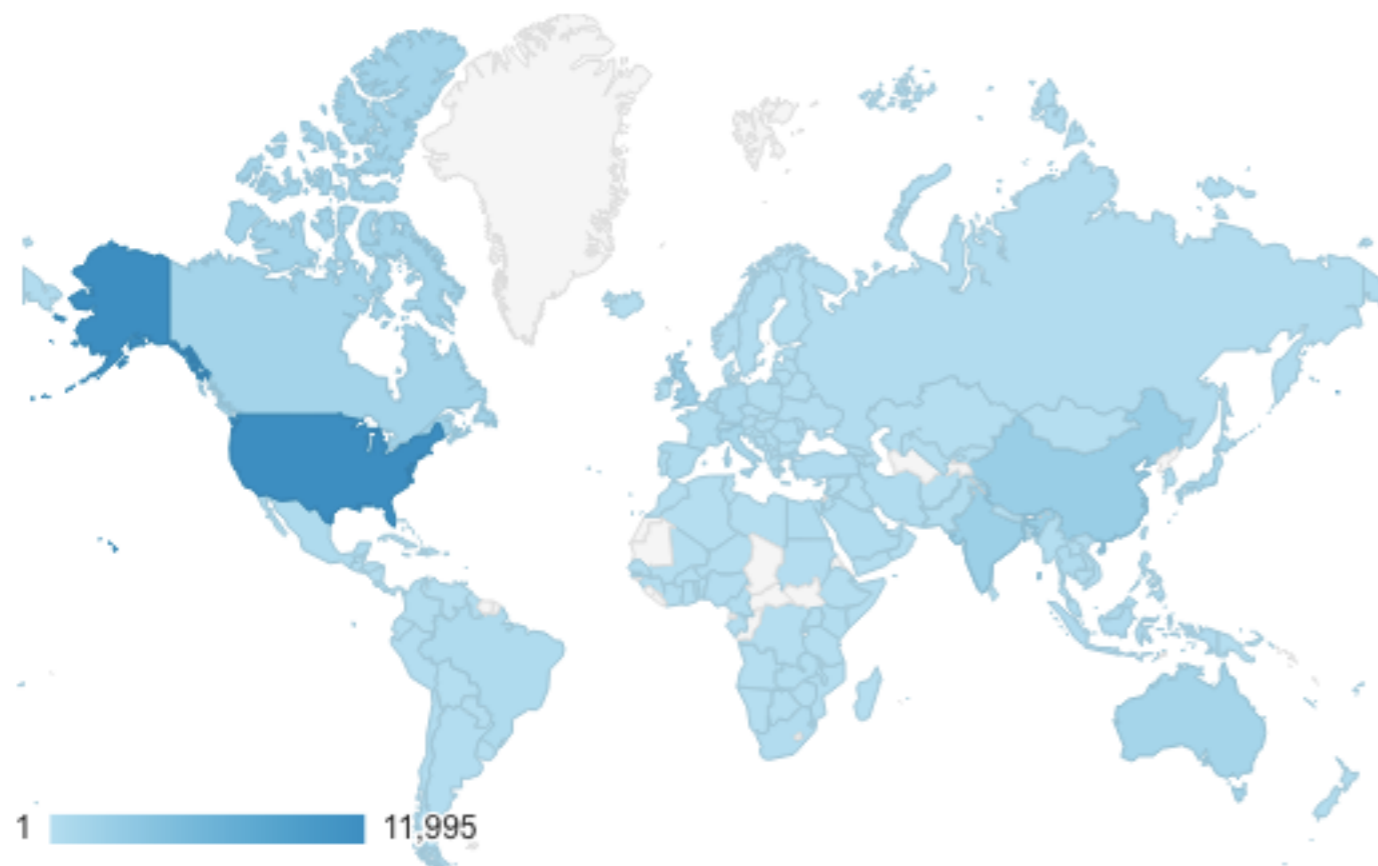
## 9. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2016
