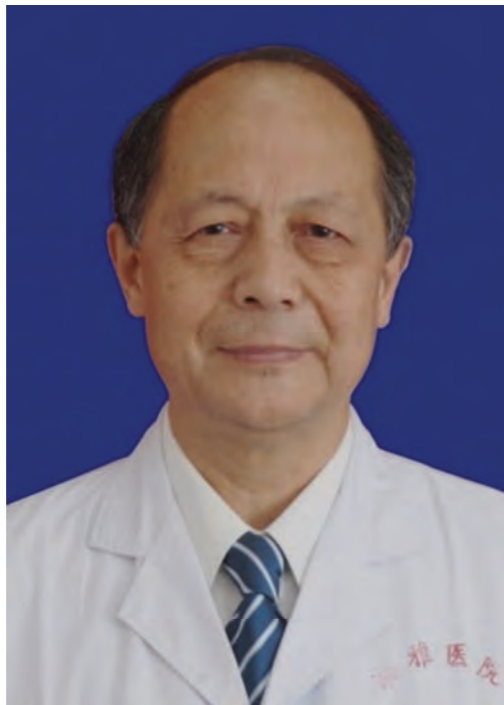

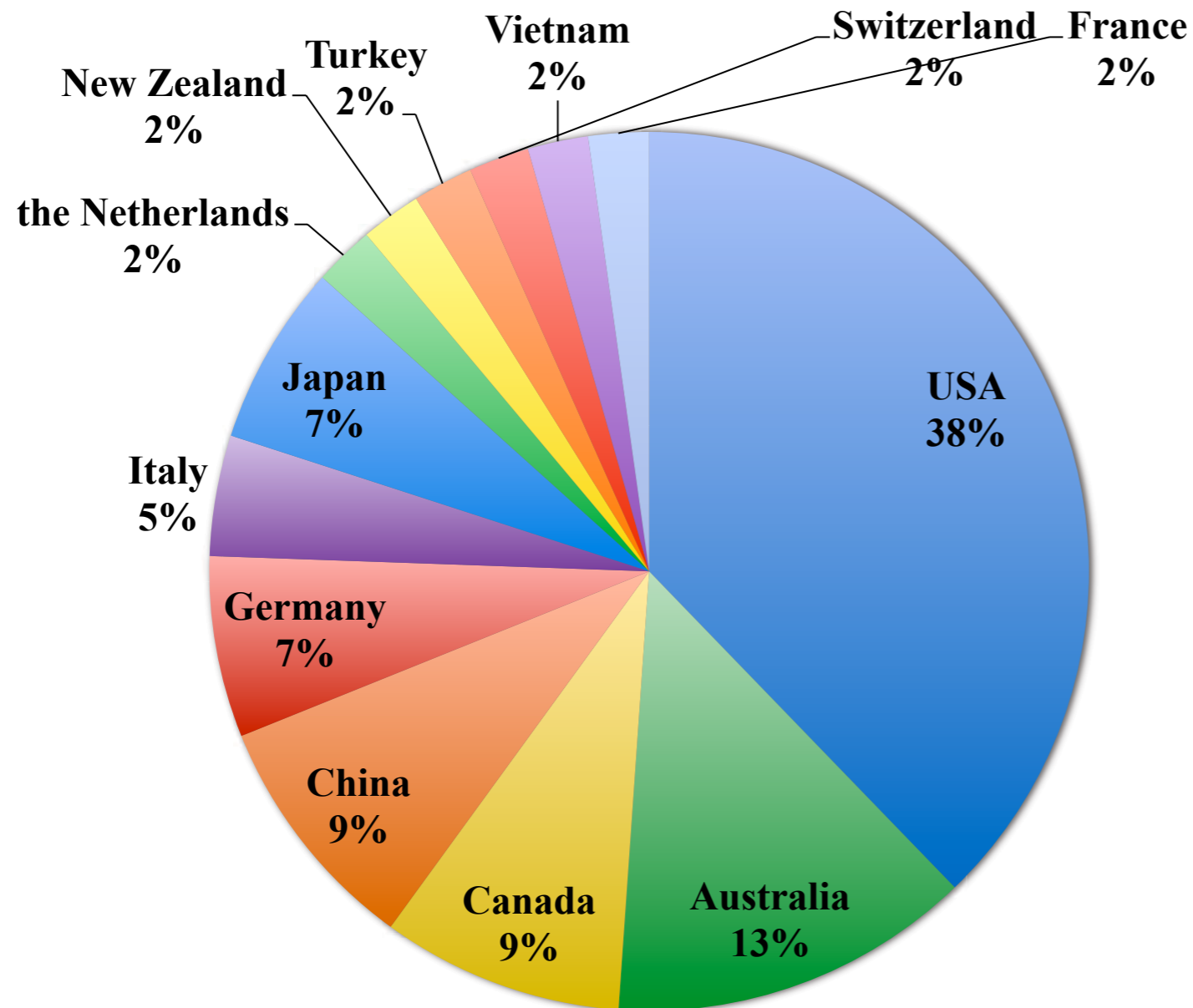

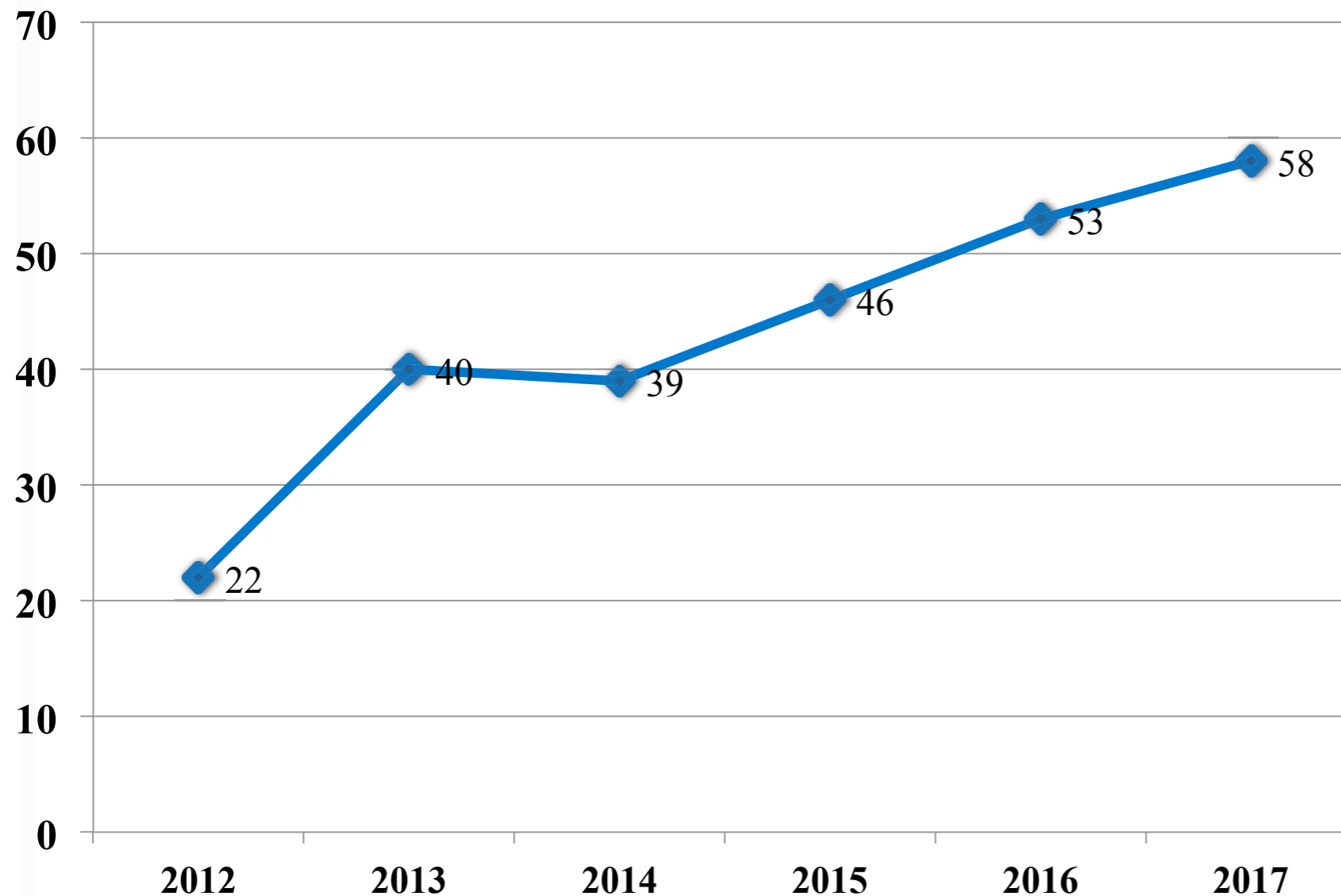
## 4. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

- 43 Editorial Board Members

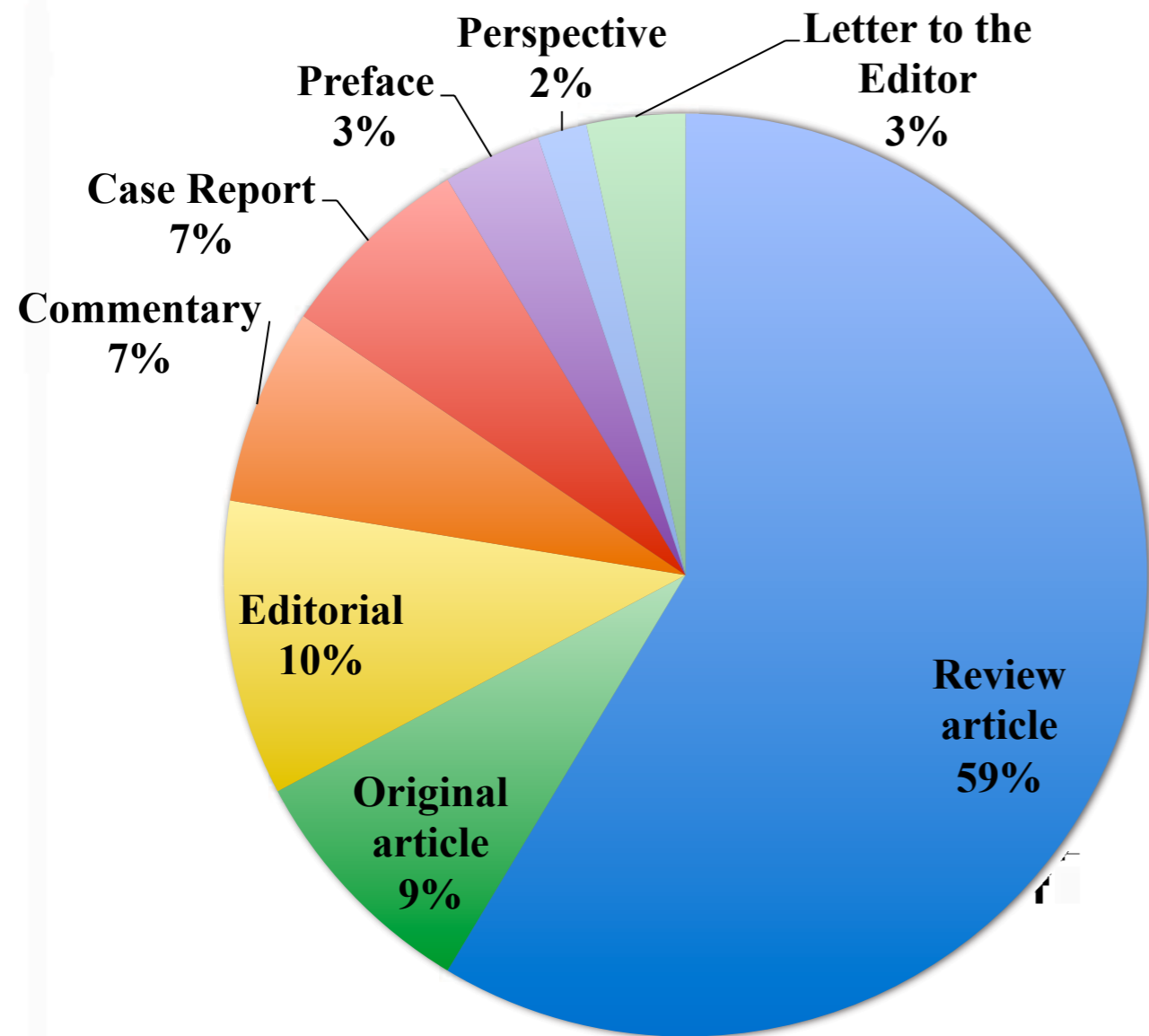
## 5. Number of Published Articles (results by year)

Number of articles has been increasing in recent four years

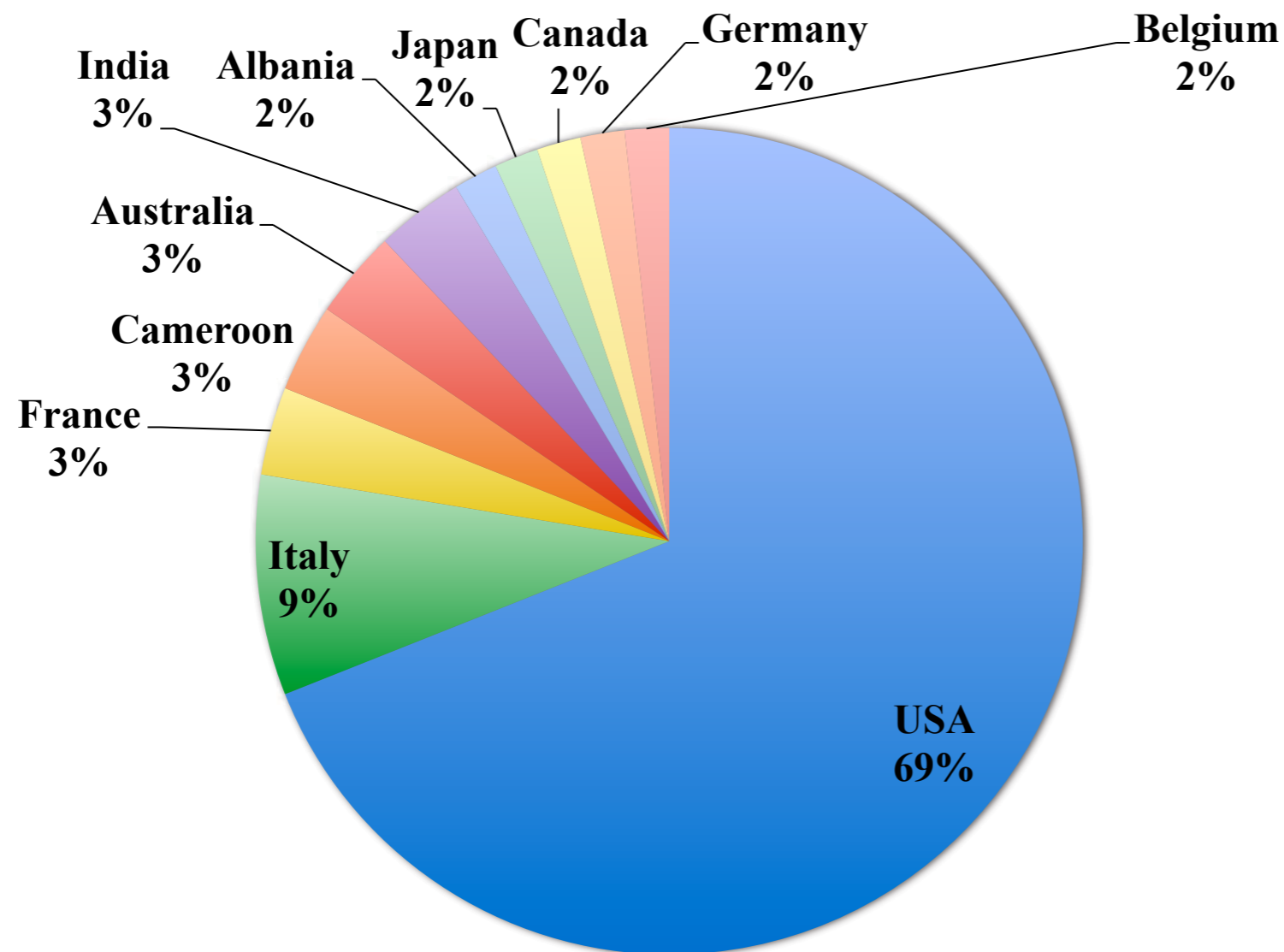
## 6. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2017



In 2017, TP has published **58** manuscripts, among which there are **39** review articles and **original** articles. Other article types include Editorials, Case reports, Commentaries, etc.

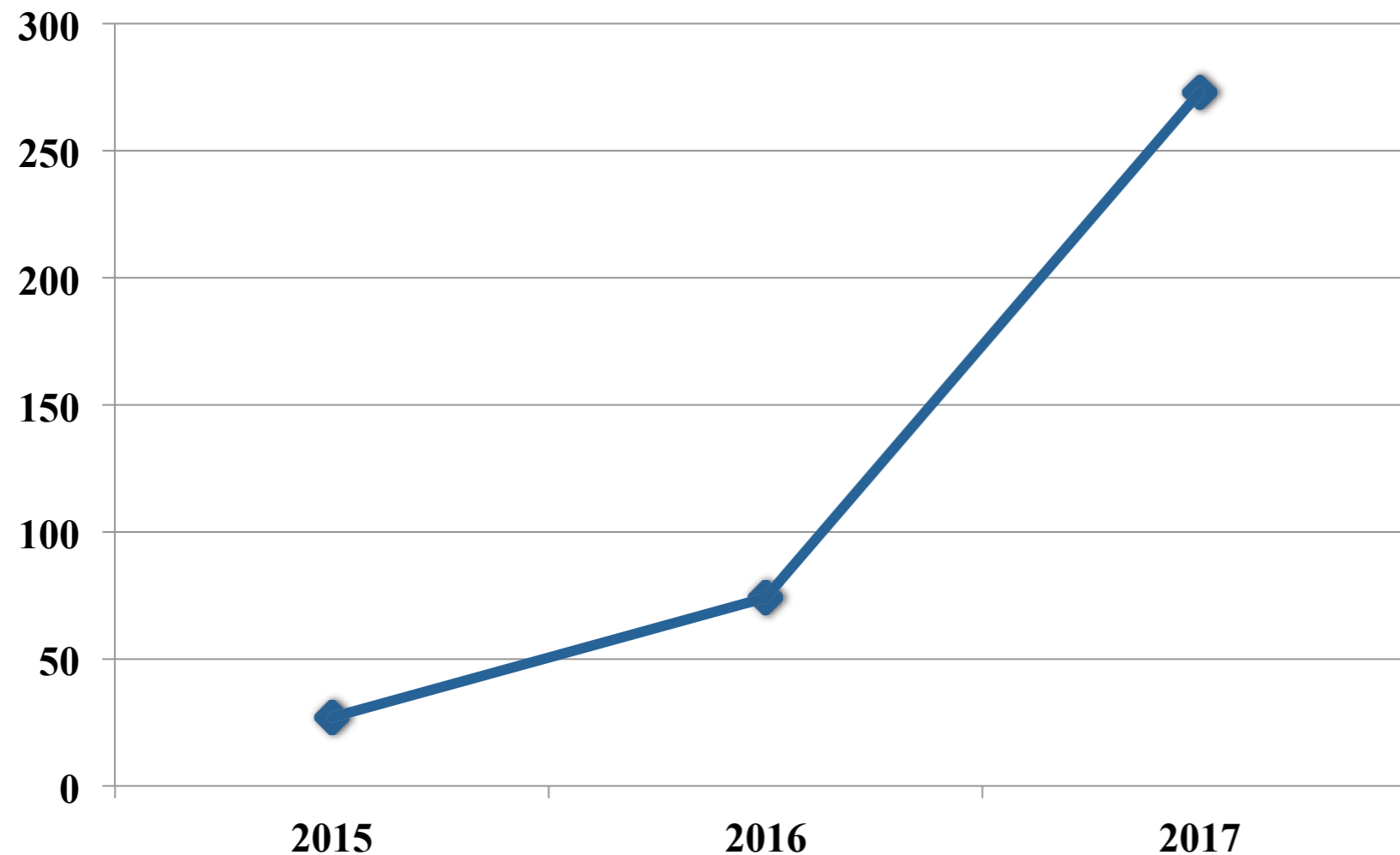


## 7. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2017



Corresponding authors of 58 articles published in 2017 come from **11 countries** with 69% of them from USA.

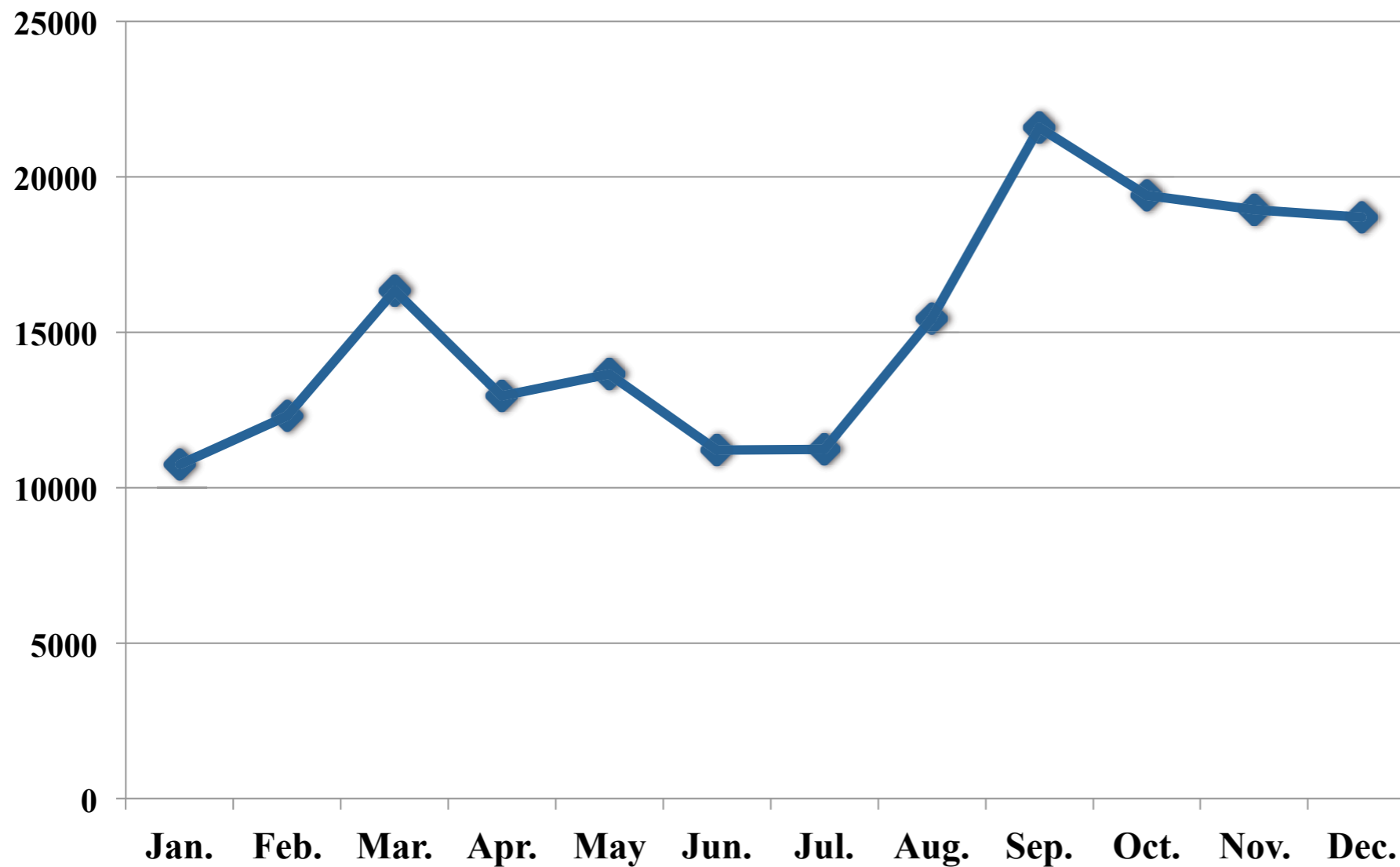
## 8. Citations in 2017 (results by year)

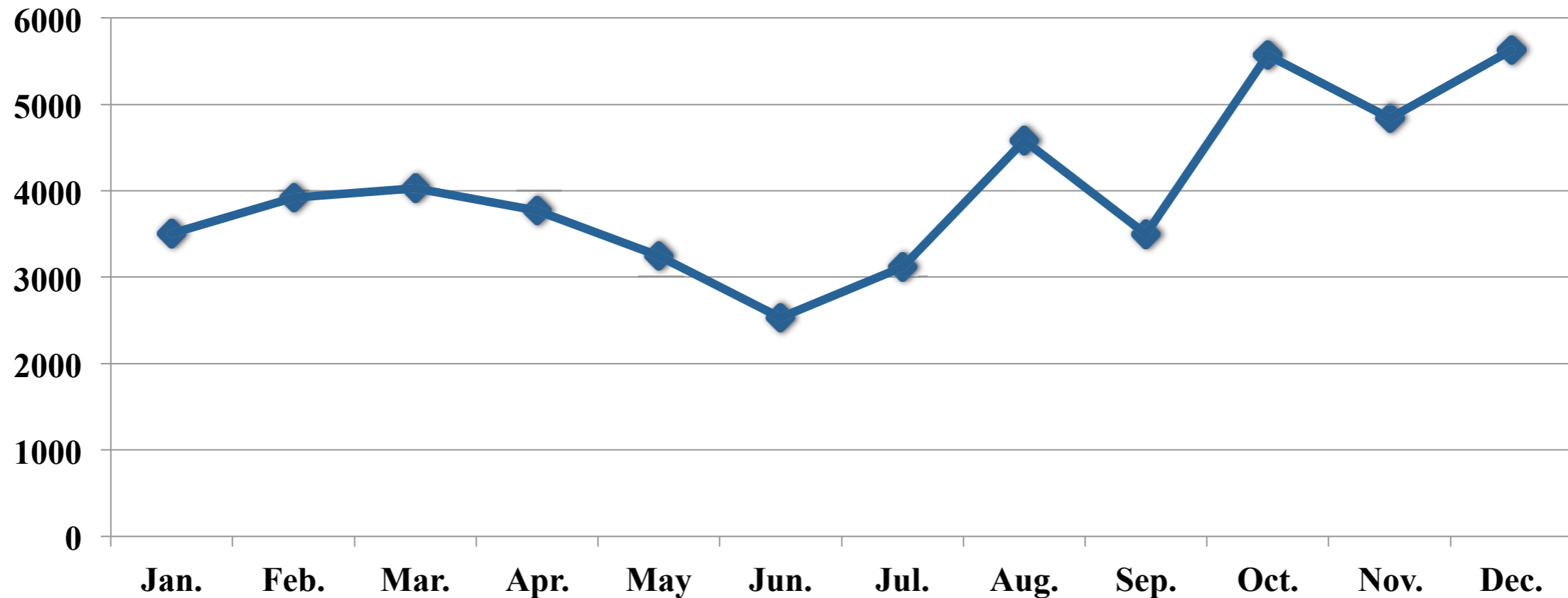
## 9. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2017
