



5. Distribution of Editorial Board Members




All together **52** Members from 14 countries, including


6. Number of Published Articles (results by year)



53 articles are published in 2018.




7. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2018

original articles.




8. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2018

9. Citations in 2018 (results by year)




Since TP was launched, TP articles have been cited 604 times by articles indexed in Web of Science Core Collection.

10. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2018




Retrieval of TP in PubMed increased rapidly with a amount of 334,692 times in 2018.
